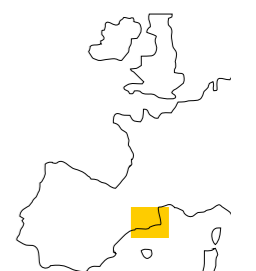
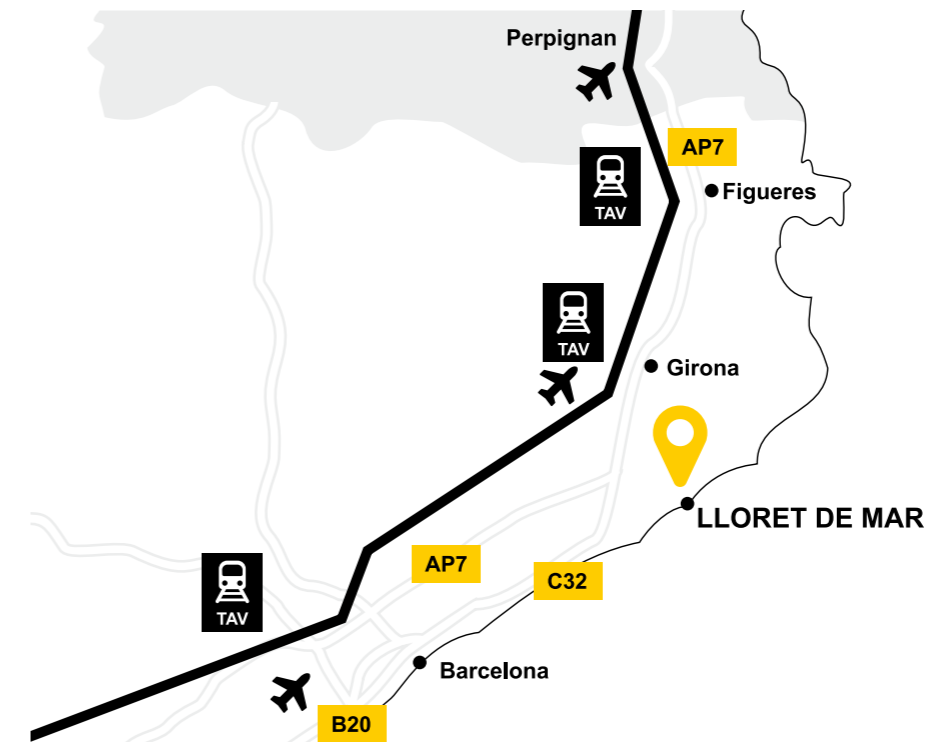

OLYMPIC CONFERENCE CENTRE

The Olympic Conference Centre has over 4,900 m2 of meeting rooms, ranging from 40 to 800 m2, for conferences, conventions and banquets. It includes a new auditorium with a capacity of 770 delegates. It is equipped with audio, video and Wi-Fi systems and forms part of the Evenia Olympic Resort, with 793 rooms (including 330 suites).

The Municipal Theatre is located in Can Saragossa Park, close to the Guitart Monterrey Hotel and to the Costa Brava Conference Centre. The theatre has an audience capacity of 370, three rehearsal rooms with independent entrances and a 274 m2 stage. There is exterior tiered seating and a stage for hosting outdoor functions.

Landscaped with terraces and set on a cliff top, Santa Clotilde Gardens offer spectacular views of the Costa Brava and the beaches of Lloret de Mar.





The gardens, with a surface area of 26,830 m², are a popular location for film shoots and for holding official and corporate events.

Santa Clotilde Gardens were declared a Cultural Asset of National Interest by the Government of Catalonia in 1995 and received the Girona Convention Bureau award for the Best Special Venue in 2005.

Thanks to its extensive cultural and natural heritage, Lloret de Mar boasts an exceptional selection of special venues: its famous beaches, an unspoiled natural attraction of the Costa Brava; the former monastery of Sant Pere del Bosc, founded in the 10th century; Cala Gran, a great beauty spot with sea views; and the area owned by the Santa Marta Hotel right next to Santa Cristina Beach, where the sand and sea merge with the Mediterranean vegetation.





COMPLEMENTARY ACTIVITIES

COSTA BRAVA CLÀSSIC

Between the sea and the mountains, a stroll along the Costa Brava.

Culture and nature, a stroll along the Costa Brava which starts in Santa Clotilde Gardens and ends with lunch or dinner next to the sea.

In Santa Clotilde Gardens, participants are greeted by professional guides who take them on a historical tour of these wonderful gardens, designed in the Italian Renaissance style and situated in an outstanding spot on the Costa Brava. The tour is followed by a boat trip departing from Fenals Beach, offering great views of the rocky coastline and cliffs of Lloret de Mar and the Costa Brava. The boat docks at one of Lloret de Mar's main beaches, where the visit is rounded off with lunch or dinner.

NORDIC WALKING ALONG THE COASTAL FOOTPATH AND EXPLORING CULTURAL HERITAGE

The goal is to combine a healthy cardio activity with an unbeatable setting, offering participants the chance to explore the forests and hiking routes of Lloret de Mar, in particular the coastal footpath, which winds its way around the 11-km coastline of the municipality.

The length, duration and section of the trail are chosen according to the needs and demands of participants. The activity begins with some brief instructions on Nordic Walking techniques and delegates are provided with all the material they need for completing the challenge. The route also enables participants to visit some of the sites of the MOLL (Open Museum of Lloret), such as the Maritime Museum, the Castle of Sant Joan or Santa Clotilde Gardens.

DAIQUIRI WORKSHOP - THE INDIANO PAST OF LLORET DE MAR



“Constantí Ribalaigua arrived in Cuba in 1914. Born in Lloret de Mar, he headed for the Americas to seek his fortune, like so many of his fellow townsfolk. Many returned with their new-found wealth to Lloret de Mar, where they became known as *Indianos*. Others left their dreams in the Caribbean, and some, including Constantí, remained in Cuba, trapped forever by the sweetness of the Caribbean, where he made history and became friends with the great Ernest Hemingway.”

With the focus on one of the most famous cocktail makers, creator of the Daiquiri, delegates discover the *Indiano* heritage of our town. This workshop combines culture, history and fun. It can be held in any of our special venues, with sea views, at the conference centre itself, at the hotel or wherever the organiser deems it convenient.
